and

GLA UNIVERSITY (GLA), INDIA


This **Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)** is drawn up and agreed upon to establish the cooperation between the Asian Institute of Technology (hereinafter referred to as **AIT**), located at Km. 42, Paholyothin Highway, Klong Neung, Klong Luang, Pathumthani, 12120, Thailand and the the GLA University (hereinafter referred to as **GLA**), located at 17km Stone, NH-2, Mathura-Delhi Road P.O. Chaumuhan, Mathura-281 406 (U.P.), India.

The **Asian Institute of Technology (AIT)** is an international institute of higher learning. It is Asia's pioneer institution established in 1959 to help meet the region's growing needs for advanced learning in engineering, science, technology and management, research and capacity building. AIT's mission is to develop highly qualified and committed professionals who will play a leading role in the sustainable development of the region and its integration into the global economy. AIT is based in Thailand.

The **GLA University**, established under U.P. State Legislative Act of 2009 (UP Act 21 of 2010) and ranked among the top Universities of Uttar Pradesh and India and has been accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with 'A' Grade and recognized by University Grants Commission (UGC) under section 12B of UGC Act of 1956. GLA University is offering a wide range of Graduate, Post-Graduate and Doctorate programmes. GLA University is approved and recognized by University Grants Commission (UGC), NCTE and Pharmacy Council of India.

ARTICLE I: PURPOSE

The purpose of the MoU is to enable cooperation between AIT and GLA by developing collaboration in the International Unified Bachelor's-Master's Degree Program, capacity building, short term student camps, training and faculty development activities.

ARTICLE II: SCOPE

The Scope of activities under this MoU are related, but not limited to:

- 2.1. Development of International Unified Bachelor's-Master's Degree Program
- 2.2. Development of Capacity Building Doctoral Program
- 2.3. Short term student education camps
- 2.4. Short term faculty development programs and visits

ARTICLE III: DURATION, TERMINATION, AND AMENDMENT

- 3.1. The MoU will be effective from the date of signing by both parties up to a period of five (5) years, and may be subject to extensions by mutual consent of the parties in writing.
- 3.2. Either party may terminate this MoU by giving six (6) months advance notice in writing to the other party.
- 3.3. The provisions of this MoU may be amended at any time with the mutual consent of the Parties in writing.
- 3.4. The amendment, termination and expiration of this MoU will not affect the terms of activities ongoing at the time of notification of amendment, termination, and expiration unless otherwise agreed upon between the parties.

ARTICLE IV: SPECIAL PROVISIONS

- 4.1. Each party will consult with and take approval of the other party to use the latter's name, the names of the latter's officials /faculty members, and the logo for the activities under this MoU, and dissemination of results, on a case-by-case basis.
- 4.2. Modalities of each type of collaboration, associated activities and financial aspects shall be mutually agreed upon on a case-by-case basis in separate Memorandum of Agreements (MoA).
- 4.3. This Memorandum of Understanding shall be governed and construed under the laws of the Kingdom of Thailand or of Government of India depending upon where the activities take place.
- 4.4. The two parties will consult with each other and attempt to resolve disputes or misunderstandings that arise in the administration of this MoU or any subsequent associated agreement informally. Any dispute, controversy or claim arising under, out of or in connection with agreement shall be settled amicably.
- 4.5. Neither Party shall be liable for any unforeseeable event beyond its reasonable control caused by the fault or negligence of such Party, which causes such Party to be unable to perform its obligations under this Agreement, and which it has been unable to overcome by the exercise of due diligence. In the event of the occurrence of such a force majeure event, the Part unable to perform shall promptly notify the other Party. It shall further use its best efforts to resume performance as quickly as possible and shall suspend performance only for such period of time as is necessary as a result of the force majeure event.




