THE FIRST PARTY and THE SECOND PARTY hereinafter referred to collectively as THE PARTIES and individually as PARTY.

In their respective capacity, THE PARTIES agree to implement the Memorandum of Agreement with the following terms and conditions:

Article 1

Purpose and Objectives

- (1) The purpose of this Memorandum of Agreement is to establish a framework within which a mutually beneficial partnership between THE PARTIES can be established by utilizing the resources, expertise, and facilities of THE PARTIES to improve the quality of education
- (2) The objective of this Memorandum of Agreement is to optimize the role of THE PARTIES to increase and develop the potential resources owned by each Party based on the provisions of the laws and regulations.

Article 2

Object

The object of this Memorandum of Agreement is the cooperation in education, research, and community service

Article 3

Scope of Cooperation

The scope of this Memorandum of Agreement includes:

- 1. Joint Research Collaboration related to Current Issues in Education and Publication Collaboration based on the Research Results.
- 2. Joint community service and Teaching collaboration with schools.
- 3. Exploration of opportunities for exchange of faculty for teaching, Seminars, guest lectures and Workshops.
- 4. Joint supervision of Ph.D. students.
- 5. Exploring opportunities for student exchanges, such as Short term / Long term mobility, Summer Schools, Semester abroad, internship.
- 6. Cultural Exchanges.
- 7. Exploration and identification of other areas of possible interest and collaboration.

Article 4

Rights and Obligations

- (1) THE PARTIES have the following rights:
 - a. to offer opportunities for students and teachers exchange program
 - b. to use the expertise and facilities of THE SECOND PARTY; and
 - c. to obtain the result of the conducted study/research.
- (2) THE PARTIES have the following obligations:
 - a. to facilitate the program/study/research activities;



Article 5

Expenses

All the financial responsibilities arising from the activities implemented under this Memorandum of Agreement shall be provided by THE PARTIES based on the agreement of THE PARTIES

Article 6

Duration and Termination

- (1) This Memorandum of Agreement shall be effective upon the date of signing and shall be valid for 3 (three) years from the date of signing.
- (2) This Memorandum of Agreement may be renewed upon its expiry and with the agreement of THE PARTIES.

Article 7

- (2) If one of **THE PARTIES** intends to change the address as referred to in paragraph (1). In that case, **THE PARTY** making the said change shall officially notify the said replacement and change through registered mail, email, or other media.
- (3) Change of address or other identity-related matters as referred to in paragraph (2) shall not affect the validity of this Memorandum of Agreement.

Article 8

Termination

- (1) This Memorandum of Agreement ends following its expiry date.
- (2) This Memorandum of Agreement may end before the period as referred to in Article 6, provided that the terminating party shall notify the other party in writing of its intention no later than 2 (two) months in advance.
- (3) This Memorandum of Agreement ends or is null if there are statutory provisions and/or government policies that do not allow this Memorandum of Agreement to take place without being bound by the period as referred to in paragraphs (1) and paragraph (2).
- (4) This Memorandum of Agreement may be terminated unilaterally if one of the parties is negligent in fulfilling its obligations as stated in Article 4.

Article 9

Force Majeure

- (1) The force majeure referred to in this Memorandum of Agreement is the occurrence of an event beyond the capabilities of THE PARTIES which results in the inability to implement this Memorandum of Agreement, such as but not limited to the occurrence of natural disasters, riots, floods, wars, fires and so fort as evidenced by a written statement by the authorities.
- (2) If one of **THE PARTIES** is affected by an event in the category of force majeure, that party is obliged to notify the other party of the incident by attaching a written statement from the competent authority no later than 14 (fourteen) days from the occurrence of the incident.
- (3) If the force majeure continues for more than a period of 30 (thirty) days, THE PARTIES shall agree to review this Memorandum of Agreement.

Article 10

Settlement of Disputes

Any dispute in the interpretation of this Memorandum of Agreement shall be settled by consultation and negotiation between **THE PARTIES**.

Article 11

Amendments

This Memorandum of Agreement may be amended by mutual agreement and consent, evidenced in writing by THE PARTIES.
