



## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter called as the 'MOU') is entered on 4<sup>th</sup> Day of March, 2022 between MSME-Technology Development Centre (PPDC), Agra and, GLA University, Mathura (Department of Mechanical Engineering).

MSME-Technology Development Centre (PPDC) Agra is Government of India Organization, Under Ministry of MSME, Foundry Nagar, Hathras Road, Agra - 208006, U.P., (hereinafter referred to as "First Party")

## AND

Department of Mechanical Engineering GLA University Mathura, (herein after referred to as "Second Party")

- The purpose of this MOU is to develop academic and educational co-operation to promote mutual understanding between the two parties.
- The two Parties agreed to develop the following collaborative activities in the areas of mutual interest.
  - a) Conducting courses on Emerging Areas of Smart Manufacturing
  - b) Training & Skill Development
  - c) Inplant Training/Summer training
  - d) Science & Technology projects
  - e) Faculty Exchange Programme
  - f) Entrepreneurship programme
  - g) Curriculum design & review
  - h) Facilitate & promotion of State & Central Govt. Schemes

However Scope & modality of working on each activities including Business model will be separately discussed & negotiated. The fees collected for undertaking any activity to be deposited with the First Party.

- Second Party will maintain all data base in prescribed format provided by the First Party.
- 4. In case, Second Party provide all required infrastructure for conducting training programme by First Party may pay some charges to the Second Party after submission of bill & completion of all necessary formalities required by First party. However the charges for such cases will be decided on case to case basis.

- 5. In case, First Party engage Faculties/Trainers of Second Party, Some charges/fees will be paid to the Second Party after satisfactory feedback received from the trainees/Students. The charges for such cases will be decided on case to case basis.

- 7. MoU can be terminated giving 3 months written notice by either party.
- 8. This MoU will be valid for five years after the date of execution and will be reviewed after one year.
