### **NOTICE**

# (Dress Code for Students - Session 2020-2021)

This is to inform all the students that following the dress-code/wearing uniform as prescribed below is compulsory for every student and expected to be in prescribed dress-code uniform once he/she is in the University campus irrespective of the lecture timings.

Non-compliance/non-wearing the prescribed dress-code will be treated as 'Disciplinary misconduct' under the Code of Conduct and will attract penalties as per the University's rules.

Having all these in consideration, the University has decided a Dress Code Policy for students.

Categories: There are mainly two categories as defined below.

Category A: This category contains the guidelines that are to be followed by students when they are in campus; attending regular classes or participating in extracurricular/ co-curricular event.
