




- This is a multiple choice test.

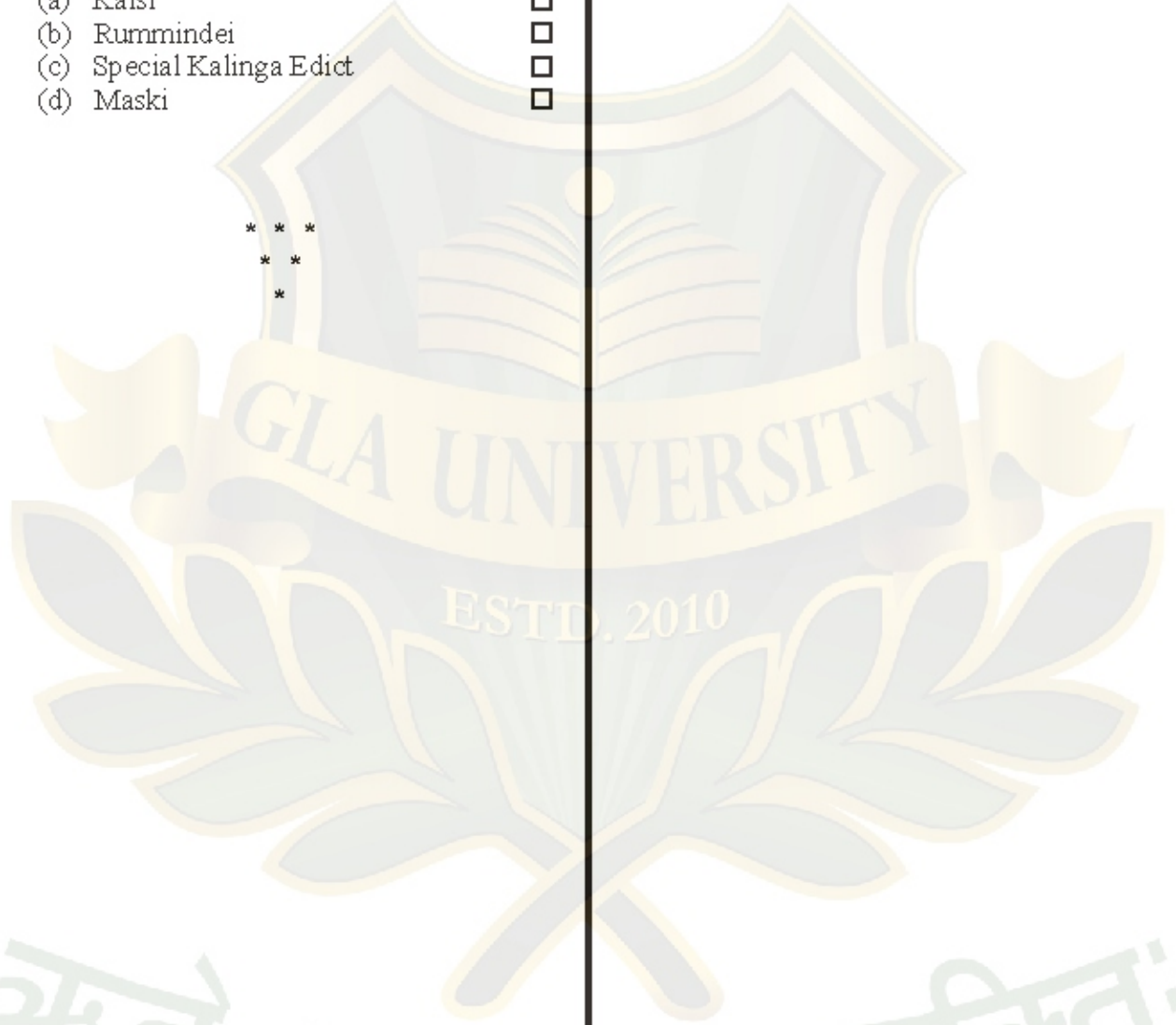
