Regarding Summer Term

Carry Over Examinations will be arranged during Summer Term with classes for students of:

- (i) First year (all degree programmes)
- (ii) Diploma in Engineering of all years,
- (iii) Students of Courses and Years under CBCS Scheme detained with attendance $\geq 50\%$.

and without classes for all other students of all degree programmes.

The limit of carry over papers with classes permissible for this examination to students shall be a maximum of **Sixteen Credits**.

The online registration for Summer Term 2018-19 would start after the declaration of result for Even Semester/Trimester and the last date would be **June 01, 2019**. The link for the registration shall be notified separately in the first week of May, 2019.

Classes for students of first year (all degree programmes) & Diploma in Engineering of all years in subjects registered for Summer Term shall be held from **May 29 to July 09, 2019** (six weeks).

Students of category (iii) as mentioned above would have to attend at least **20/16/12 Lectures** for a **4/3/2 credit course** for appearing in this Carry Over Examination. Classes of such students shall be arranged before **July 09, 2019** and notified separately by the concerned Head of the Department.

The carry over examinations for subjects with and without classes shall be of three hours' duration with question papers of 80 marks from entire syllabus as per the format attached herewith and displayed on the Notice Boards of the Examination Cell as well as Departments by the HoD.

Examinations of Summer Term shall be held from 10-16 July, 2019 and the result shall be declared on 23 July, 2019.

The examination schedule will be made available in *examination menu on website of the University by June 29, 2019*. It shall be the responsibility of the student appearing in this carry over examination to see this schedule (latest and revised, if any) and appear in examination on scheduled date and time. No separate intimation will be sent to any individual student regarding the examination schedule and any change therein.

Students having any queries shall contact respective Heads of the Departments or in case of any further difficulty then undersigned, in time.

Kindly note:

1. Students of Courses under CBCS scheme detained with attendance $< 50\%$ and having F* grade are not eligible for the above said Carry Over Examination. They have to repeat the course in regular semester only.
