NOTICE

Carry Over Examinations for theory subjects will be arranged during Summer Term with classes for students of: (i) First year (all degree programmes) (ii) Diploma in Engineering of all years, and without classes for non-first year students of all degree programmes.

The limit of carry over papers with classes permissible for this examination to students shall be a maximum of **Sixteen Credits.**

Form No. 2 (attached herewith) will be used for registration of carry over subjects without classes for this examination.

Form No. 3 (*attached herewith*) will be used for registration of carry over subjects **with classes** for this examination.

These forms will be available from office of the HoD / window counter of Room No. 122 of Academic Block-I for all eligible students up to **June 07, 2018** only. The duly completed Forms No. 2 & 3 will be accepted for **registration from April 18 to June 07, 2018** in Room No. 118 in person in Academic Block-I only. Thereafter, no form will be accepted for registration.

Classes for students of first year (all degree programmes) & Diploma in Engineering of all years in subjects registered for Summer Term shall be held from **04 June to 14 July, 2018** (six weeks from Monday to Saturday).

The carry over examinations for subjects with and without classes shall be of three hours' duration with question papers of 80 marks from entire syllabus as per the format attached herewith and displayed on the Notice Boards of the Examination Cell as well as Departments by the HoD.

Examinations of Summer Term shall be held from 16-21 July, 2018 and the result shall be declared on 28 July, 2018.

The examination schedule will be made available in *examination menu on website of* the *University by July 05, 2018*. It shall be the responsibility of the student appearing in this carry over examination to see this schedule (latest and revised, if any) and appear in examination on scheduled date and time. No separate intimation will be sent to any individual student regarding the examination schedule and any change therein.
