- II. **Mr. Ashok Kumar Singh, Registrar of GLA University, Mathura**, therefore acting for and on behalf of GLA University address in 17km Stone, NH-19, Mathura-Delhi Road P.O. Chaumuhan, Mathura-281 406 (U.P.) India, hereinafter referred to as **SECOND PARTY**.

ARTICLE 1
SCOPE

ARTICLE 2
DURATION

- (1) This MoU is effective as of the date (date) to (date) for a period of 5 Years and can be extended in line with the terms and conditions based on the agreement of both PARTIES.
- (2) Termination of this cooperation by a PARTY before the duration period has ended, the respective PARTY is required to provide prior written notice to the other PARTY 3 months before.

ARTICLE 3
FINANCING

FORCE MAJEURE

- (1) In the event of Force Majeure during the cooperation such as natural disaster, riot, flood, war, fire and other related event beyond the capability of both PARTIES, resulting in the impossibility for the implementation of this cooperation is required a written proof from the official.
- (2) If a PARTY is affected, the respective PARTY is required to inform the other PARTY along with the written proof from the official at the latest 14 (fourteen) days after the initial event.
- (3) In the event of Force Majeure occurs over 30 days, thus each PARTY agreed to review the terms and conditions of the MoU.

**ARTICLE 6
DISPUTE RESOLUTION**

- (1) Should there be a dispute in the implementation of this MoU, the PARTIES agree to settle it by consensus
- (2) In the event the PARTIES does not reach consensus, the PARTIES agree to settle disputes in accordance with the applicable laws and regulations.

**ARTICLE 7
MISCELLANEOUS**

- (1) Amendments to this MoU is only permitted based on the agreement between the FIRST PARTY and the SECOND PARTY.
- (2) Matters that haven't been regulated in this MoU shall be regulated and set in an addendum agreed by FIRST PARTY and SECOND PARTY and is an integral part of this MoU

**ARTICLE 8
CLOSING PROVISION**

The MoU is made in duplicate 2 (two), each sufficiently stamped and handed to the PARTIES where each PARTY has the same legal force.
