



Agenda: Discussion on Action Items for Policy Formulation, Brainstorming and Identifying Thrust Areas for Intervention

3. Startup Policy documents for institutes which has good entrepreneurship ecosystem along with Incubation center to be studied and few points can be incorporated while formation of GLAU Innovation & Start-up Policy (GISP).
4. Also NISP Policy which is available on following link: https://mic.gov.in/assets/doc/startup_policy_2019.pdf will be followed and important points like IP Ownership, Faculty & Student Startup equity guidelines & other must be in line with formulated policy.
5. Also UP Start-up Policy to be studied & important points to be incorporated for formulation of GISP <https://nri.up.gov.in/site/writereaddata/siteContent/202009111027036780Startup-Policy-2020.pdf>
6. University's entrepreneurship ecosystem like IIC, E-Cell, NewGen IEDC, and Start-up Launchpad must be synergized to achieve the policy objectives. Also various non-technical institutes of GLAU need to be consider while formulating policy.
7. Thrust Area for intervention will be Introducing startup case studies as one of the assessment methods, department-wise innovation faculty coordinator, incentivizing (in terms of academics) B-Plan & Entrepreneurship event participation, E-Cell GLAU will be given more importance, Highlighting Student Startup achievements on social media & university's brochure/prospectus.
8. Next Meeting on finalization short term and long term plans (3 Years), KPIs and other milestones.


